# **Programme**

# Friday 11th April

# Sunday 13th April Marlborough Sounds - Queen Charlotte

Points of interest along the route are:

Kaipupu Point sanctuary and Shakespeare Bay log wharf. Wilding pine control by Marlborough Sounds Restoration Trust.

Ruakaka Bay – salmon farm.

<u>Disembark</u> at Hitaua Bay, Tory Channel – Moore's property forest walk.

Bay of Many Coves/Farnham Forest – forest clearing/residential development.

Motuara Island – off shore island biodiversity management. Arapawa Island – whaling, pine harvesting.

<u>Disembark</u> at Ship Cove - history of James Cook's visits to the area and Joseph Banks accounts of the bio diversity.

### Sunday 13<sup>th</sup> April Marlborough Sounds – Pelorus

Points of interest along the route to Hopai Farm are: Kaituna sawmill - Maher's forest & forestry Kaituna Valley. Havelock - Sandford's mussel factory.

Mahakipawa Arm - Tai Tane Forest.

Kaiuma Bay - Yealand's forest and subdivision.

Mahau Sound - Skiddaw; recent logging.

Nikau and Four Fathom Bay – forestry.

Maori Bay - pine harvesting & early durable eucalypt planting.

Penguin Bay, Fairy Bay & Dillon Bell Bay - retain areas of original native forest.

Northwest Bay /South East Bay - pine forests, harvesting operation in NW Bay.

Old Homewood Bay, Pohuenui, Clova Bay & Crail Bays. <u>Disembark</u> at Hopai Bay – Farming operation & forestry plantings, bio diversity protection and restoration.

# Sunday 13<sup>th</sup> April Terra Firma

Koromiko/Para - Marlborough Regional Forestry. Kaipupu Point sanctuary and Shakespeare Bay log wharf. Momorangi Bay – DOC speaker and morning tea.

Linkwater - Shallcrass macrocarapa forest & milling operation. Anakiwa - Outward Bound Kahikatea grove followed by lunch. Mahakipawa Arm - Tai Tane Forest diverse species harvest and milling with a portable bandsaw.

Cullen's Pt. lookout - Havelock estuary & Pelorus/Kaituna Rivers.

Kaituna Valley – Jefferswood native & amenity trees with afternoon refreshments.

Marlborough Ridge – Wentworth native restoration. Lake Timara; 110yr old Eucalyptus stand Waihopai Valley Rd. The Throne – farm forestry and vineyard. The Pyramid - SI Farm Forrester of the Year 2008. The day ends with the final dinner and auction.
